John 4:24

Two things I want you to think of is in spirit and in truth.

In Computer world we have something called G.I.G.O
- garbage in garbage out
pretty much - you get what you put in.

In spirit and in truth.

I want to start with the last word truth.

What is truth?

Anyone wants to tell me the meaning of the word?
Truth means a fact or believe that is accepted as true.
Now let's turn to ourselves for a moment and ask ourselves how truthful are

we with ourselves? Because what I discovered is that the worst lie you can ever tell – is a lie to yourself.

And since truth is a fact or belief that is accepted and if the fact or believe is founded on lies where does that leave you?

If your whole foundation is based on the lie how long do you think you will survive? Sooner or later we will be exposed as it is written in

Esscl 12:14
For God will bring every deed into judgment including every hidden thing whether it is good or evil.

So why are we starting here? Because if we truly are going to discover, find the person called me, we have to be honest, be naked before God, nobody else just you and your maker!

God is Spirit and his worshipers must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Do I have any questions in regards to where we need to be before we embark on his wonderful journey?

Okay so we all now have our Truth Glasses on?
Let's start out with our Journey.

Here it is:
It all started while I was reading Proverbs 23:1-2

Can I have someone please read that.

The last phrase is what caught my attention:
if you are a man given to appetite, gluttony, another version says a big eater. Well, in order to know if I'm any of these then it stands that I must know myself pretty well. So the question how does one get to know themselves came up. And the response I got was:

Finding the Person Called Me

Know your worth, your strengths and your weakness.

Three things
WORTH
STRENGTHS
WEAKNESS

Let's examine each one

1) Worth – know your worth as described by God

Matthew 16:13-15 can I have someone read this

It's interesting Jesus asked his disciples; who people say he is and then who they say he is.

Let's let that sit for a moment.

Who do people say I am?

Who do you say I am?

Let's look at the meaning of the word worth?

An indefinite quality of something having a specific value.

The quality that renders something valuable or useful

Who can tell me the meaning of this word

Indefinite

It means lasting for an unknown or unstated length of time not clearly expressed or defined; vague: So if worth is in indefinite which means they are not clearly defined; vague so it stands that someone has to determine the value of that thing. Right?

So my question therefore is who is defining your worth? Is it people around you or those close to you or is it YOU? The bottom line is someone or something has to define it, so it might as well be YOU!!

The call is yours.

Now let's look back at our foundation Scripture

God is spirit and his worshipers must worship him in spirit and in truth

Let's deal with the other with Spirit.

God is spirit that's a fact a belief that we all accept as truth. Right? So if he is Spirit and he says we must worship him in spirit, then we can conclude that his spirit and our spirit must be in tune? So what I'm I getting at? To begin to find yourself you must begin to find what God is saying about you!

Know your worth as described by God.

So where do you begin?

By asking yourself – who do you say you are?
who are you being?
what do you want to be recognised for?
how do you want to be seen?

Then go to the good book and find scriptures that say what you just said about yourself.

Too many times we let, Fear, fear of rejection, Fear of being alone, accepted, keep us from really embracing who we truly are. So we try being someone or something else so we can be accepted, be a part of something while at the same time our spirit cries out and we wonder why our happiness is so temporary only when you are being that person.

Finding the Person Called Me

Solomon in Ecc 2:1-3, 10-11 describes all this as Meaningless
But it doesn't need to be so. You can choose to have meaning – know your worth as described by God.

So for me I see myself as of noble character and priceless because in Proverbs 31:10 it reads

A wife of noble character who can find? She is worth far more than rubies.

God says I'm of noble character and worth is far more than rubies.

Why do you need to find scriptures to back you up? Well, other than being in tuned with God it allows you the right weapons to fight the enemy when he comes up to you with his lies saying: you know you are not all that. You can say yes I may not be all that but my father says I'm all day so I choose to go with what my father says!!

Does anyone have any scriptures they want to share?

For the men I particular love the description I found in Psalms 45

Know your worth as described by God.

Are we good here?

Okay now let's look at strengths

Know your strengths as what God has placed within you

Once again who can tell me the meaning of strength

Strength means the property of being physically or mentally strong

- An assets of special worth or utility
- The emotional or mental qualities necessary in dealing with situations or events that are distressing or difficult .

- The capacity of an object or substance to withstand great force or pressure.

Your strengths are the things or activities that you do easily, they just come naturally to you. No one taught you you just picked up that instrument started playing, drawing, solving that equation. You can't explain how you did it, you just did!

God placed those things in you. And the thing is, because it comes so naturally to you, you don't really think too much about it until someone asks you how did you do that? Take a moment and ask yourself what are some things you do that just blows people away?

Exodus 31:2-5

See, I have called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah: And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship, To devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, And in cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of timber, to work in all manner of workmanship

I have called _____

And I have filled him/her with the Spirit of God with skill, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in all manner of workmanship.

The last one weakness

Know your weakness so God will be glorified

As usual let's look at the meaning of weakness

Weakness means the flaw or weak point; powerlessness revealed by an inability to act

Finding the Person Called Me

Your weakness are usually things you really don't like doing. They make you uncomfortable, you always find excuses, it takes you for ever to get to it, it's the very last thing you would ever volunteer for

The tricky thing about weaknesses are they can also be undiscovered strengths. Our fear or lack of knowledge may make them appear as our weakness.

2 Corinthians 12:9

And he hath said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee:for my power is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my weaknesses, that the power of Christ may rest upon me

So why should you be afraid of your weakness knowing that God is made strongest in our weakness.

So embrace those limitations, weakness so God will be glorified.

To recap:

- 1) Know your worth as described by God
- 2) Know your strengths as to what God has placed within you and lastly
- 3) Know your weakness so God can be glorified

Wonderful, this is all nice, I know my Worth, Strengths and Weakness what's next? How can I know I'm really hearing right, make the right choices, how can I apply this to my life now.

How can I make this applicable to my situation and this is what I received

When opportunities or situations comes your way ask yourself the following questions

Does this play into my strengths or weaknesses?

Will God be glorified when it is accomplished?

Will it serve the Kingdom?

Will it accomplish my purpose?

For 2016 we all have accepted the mandate of 7X4 growth of the fellowship now knowing these three things how can you personally help accomplish this

To bring my presentation to an end I will draw from our book the Super Alts section 3—total well-being Putting together the whole man

Who are you in Christ?

Do you know your worth?

Do you know your strengths?

Do you know your weakness?

There's a wheel in that section that if you've never ever examine your life I will highly encourage you to do so however I have a small twist to it and this was another chat I had with my heavenly Father. The wheel asks you to rate yourself on a scale of 1 to 10. God pointed out that we as humans, are our own worse critics and we will always find ourselves short. The world is always judging us to how well we do any and each year when we sit down to evaluate ourselves we rate ourself .

STOP judging yourself short, if I made you then you are good, you are a perfect 10

So start from 10 then take a look at those areas and ask yourself what changes do I want to see What new experiences do I want to have?

Bring those desires, requests to me and let's deal them.

So let's examine ourselves to know ourselves and confidently accomplish his work.
